



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. *How much are tickets?*

Advanced tickets are \$20. Onsite tickets are \$25. Designated Driver (non-drinking) tickets are available for \$10. Group tickets are \$15 each and are available only by telephone: 615-758-3478. Please be advised that PHOTO ID is required for entry.

2. *What do I get with the price of admission?*

Adult admission includes a logoed souvenir wine glass, unlimited wine sampling, free wine & food seminars, free gourmet specialty food samples, and free lake cruises.

3. *How do I get advanced tickets?*

Advanced tickets are available on the website; at the Chamber of Commerce office located at 46 West Caldwell Street in Mt. Juliet, TN; or by phone at 615-758-3478.

4. *Where is Nashville Shores?*

Nashville Shores is located just a few miles from Nashville, Tennessee right off I-40 East. For a map and detailed directions to Nashville Shores, please check out the *INFO* page of the website.

5. *If I purchase a ticket and then realize that I cannot attend, can I get a refund?*

All ticket sales are final and non-refundable.

6. *Is there a rain date in case of inclement weather?*

The festival is open rain or shine. Please note that even though the entire festival venue is not covered, each tasting tent is under cover.

7. *Am I allowed to bring my children to this festival?*

Children are not discouraged; however, please remember that this is a wine festival and may not be an appropriate venue for children.

8. *Is there a special price for children?*

Children 12 and under are FREE. Children over 12 must purchase a Designated Driver Ticket.

9. *Is my admission to the wine festival also good for Nashville Shores?*

Wine festival admission is good for the wine fest ONLY. If you wish to participate in water activities at Nashville Shores, you must purchase a separate ticket. The perimeter between the two venues is fenced off to discourage trespassing.

10. *Am I allowed to bring in my own cooler and lawn chairs?*

No outside food and beverages are permitted. Gourmet Specialty Food vendors will give out complimentary samples of their products and concessions booths will also be set up around the festival venue for food purchases. Lawn chairs and blankets are welcome; however, picnic tables are strategically placed around each tasting tent for your convenience.

11. *Can I bring my pet?*

No pets are allowed on the festival site.

12. *How do I get admission to the wine and food seminars?*

Wine & Food seminars are offered hourly and are FREE on a first-come-first-served basis. Each seminar lasts approximately 20 minutes and seats approximately 50 persons. Seminars are announced on the loudspeaker beforehand, so be sure to make your way to the seminar tent right away if you are interested in attending one of these events.

13. *What is there for me to do at the wine fest if I do not wish to sample wine?*

This festival is so well-rounded that we offer all-day entertainment even if you do not wish to sample wine. You may take advantage of the complimentary gourmet food samples, visit the fine artisan booths, find a seat in the shade and enjoy the live music, take a free lake cruise, or sit in the grass and enjoy the warm sunshine and a view of the lake.

14. *Can I purchase wine to take home?*

Each Tennessee winery offers wine for sale by the bottle or the case. Be sure to ask about case discounts.

15. *How can I become a Vendor at A Toast to Tennessee Wine Festival?*
